

What to do on Election Day



STAGE 1 ACCREDITATION PROCESS.

Polling units will open at 8 am for Accreditation and close at 1.00pm



1. Take your PVC to your polling unit where you registered and join the queue
2. Present your PVC to the electoral officer, who then matches the photograph in the book to the PVC and then reads the PVC with the card reader to authenticate voters PVC
3. The card reader will be used for to authenticate your fingerprint
4. At the next desk indelible ink will be applied below the nail section of the thumb and an accreditation tag will be given

STAGE 2 VOTING PROCEDURE.



1. Join the queue with the intention of casting your vote
2. When it gets to your turn, show your accreditation tag and ensure your name is ticked in the voter register
3. You would be given a ballot paper listing out the political parties and your thumb will be inked
4. Enter the booth and select your preferred candidate by inking the box
- 5: Place your ballot paper in the ballot box
6. Voting ends at 4.00pm
7. You can wait to see the votes counted at your Polling Unit
8. When the total is recorded it will be written down and posted on the wall at every Polling Unit

Voting starts 1:30 pm.
